

# DeBoville Slough Birding Checklist

The following is a list of the 170 or so bird species observed in the Deboville Slough area. The species have been classified as common, uncommon or rare according to the likelihood of a sighting when in-season.

**C - Common** is defined as a species that should be found, in suitable habitat, on most visits.

**U - Uncommon** indicates that the species is not easily found but is present in limited numbers and/or is secretive and hard to spot.

**R - Rare** means that the species can be present in very low numbers or may be very difficult to find.

**Sp - Spring, S - Summer, F - Fall, W - Winter, indicate when the species was seen or is most likely to be seen.**
